

## 2024 STRATFORD CHOIR BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION

## Stratford Choir Booster Club Bravo Scholarship - Two (2) Recipients

- Family is a member of booster club
- Recipient is a senior who has been in choir for 3 years and haS participated in the all-state audition process or solo/ensemble competition at least once.
- Scholarship committee will attempt to award at least one recipient who is planning on a four-year college or two-year conservatory program with a major in Vocal Performance, Music Education, Music Theory/Composition, Musical Theatre, Music Education, Music Therapy or Music Business.
- \$500 Awarded during Choir Banquet
- Applicants will be reviewed with the following priority:
  - o involvement with choir
  - director assessment
  - academics
  - o other SHS and community extracurricular activities
- Applicants will be required to complete the application, submit an unofficial transcript (skyward transcripts acceptable) and a short essay
- Upon receipt of the scholarship application, the review committee will send assessment forms to the Marcie Baker, Choir Director. Either she or Gyasi Blanton, Assistant Choir Director, will assess each candidate.

## Stratford Choir Booster Club Voice Lesson Scholarship - Two (2) recipients

- Family is a member of Stratford Choir Booster Club
- Recipient is a current freshman, sophomore or junior in one of the Stratford Choirs and plans to participate in either the all-state audition or solo and ensemble process.
- \$400 to be used toward eight (8) \$50 lessons awarded during Choir Banquet
- Applicants will be reviewed with the following priority:
  - o involvement with choir
  - director assessment`
  - academics (to ensure they are eligible to participate in all-state and/or solo and ensemble process)
- Applicants will be required to complete the application, submit an unofficial transcript (Skyward transcripts acceptable) and a short essay
- Applications will be submitted to the Scholarship Committee made up of past choir parents in addition to an assessment of the candidate by either choir director

## Stratford Choir Booster Club All-State Audition Camp Scholarship - Two (2) recipients

- Family is a member of Stratford Choir Booster Club
- Recipient is a current freshman, sophomore or junior in one of the Stratford Choirs and plans to participate in the All-State audition process.
- \$150 to be used towards either an overnight or day camp
- Applicants will be reviewed with the following priority:
  - o involvement with choir
  - director assessment`
  - academics (to ensure they are eligible to participate in all-state and/or solo and ensemble process)
- Applicants will be required to complete the application, submit an unofficial transcript (Skyward transcripts acceptable) and a short essay
- Applications will be submitted to the Scholarship Committee made up of past choir parents in addition to an assessment of the candidate by either choir director.
